

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE FOX HUNTING IN MITCHELL COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA (78001)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MITCHELL COUNTY:

Section 1. Authority

This ordinance is adopted pursuant to Chapter 113 of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

Section 2.

The fox is hereby classified as a game animal and may be taken with dogs only, at any time during the year and at any time during the day or night.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall apply within the territorial boundaries of Mitchell County, North Carolina.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption.
