**IN RE: ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MITCHELL COUNTY SHERIFF'S
DEPARTMENT TO LEAD FUNERAL PROCESSIONS**

Upon motion made by Commissioner Lee Roy Ledford, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Jenkins, the Mitchell County Board of Commissioners adopted the following Ordinance:

WHEREAS, the County deems it necessary and proper for the Mitchell County Sheriff's Department to provide a vehicle as an escort for all funeral processions that are required to travel over the roads of Mitchell county; and

WHEREAS, the County is authorized under State Law to promote this service by the Mitchell County Sheriff's Department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mitchell County Sheriff's Department shall provide an escort for all funeral processions traveling the roads of Mitchell County, and shall employ and all methods of traffic control to insure that funeral processions are permitted to pass unhindered, including, but not limited to, stopping all other traffic at intersections which the funeral procession must pass through.
