AN AMENDED ORDINANCE REGULATING THE

OF ITINERANT MERCHANTS,

DRUMMERS AND

IN MITCHELL COUNTY, NORTH

CAROLINA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mitchell County Board of Commissioners that an ordinance regulating the business activities of itinerant merchants, salesmen,

promoters, drummers and peddlers in Mitchell County, North Carolina is hereby enacted as follows.

No itinerant merchant, salesman, promoter, drummer or peddler shall conduct any business activities anywhere in Mitchell County, North Carolina

without having first obtained a permit to conduct such business activities from the Mitchell County Tax Supervisor. This permit shall be given upon the payment of the sum of \$250.00 per year to Mitchell County as a permit fee for said permit. This permit shall be conditioned upon the applicant's

demonstration of proper credentials and proof of financial stability of the applicant or upon the demonstration that the applicant has applied for and obtained a similar permit in another jurisdiction.

Expected from the prohibitions of this Ordinance shall be any person or persons involved as vendors or other participants in the Mitchell County/Spruce Pine Mineral and Gem Festival, and any other persons or individuals acting as vendors or participants in any gem or mineral related activity or business in Mitchell County, North Carolina.

Upon receipt of the requisite permit fee, the Mitchell County Tax Supervisor shall issue the required permit to the applicant.

This Ordinance is passed pursuant to NCGS 153A-125 and is enforceable as provided for therein.

This Ordinance shall become effective on May 9, 1994.
